

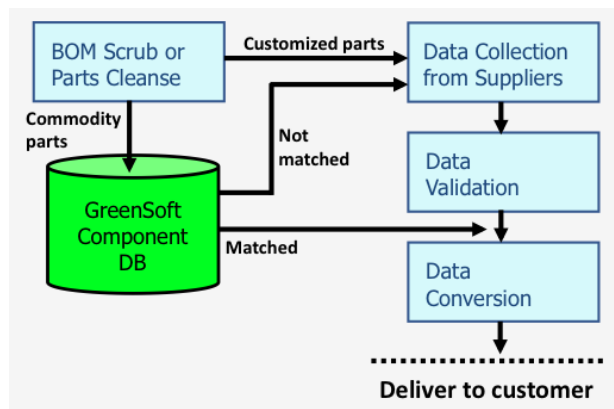
Data Collection of RoHS, REACH, FMD and Conflict Minerals Data

Best Practice for Compliance Due Diligence

Complying with changing environmental regulations and directives, such as REACH SVHC and RoHS, has become a challenging task for electronics OEMs. Certificates of compliance alone are no longer adequate to handle the frequent changes to environmental regulations, such as additions to the SVHC Candidate List and EU RoHS Recast. Collecting and processing Full Material Declaration (**FMD**) data is the **best practice** for compliance management now and in the future because it eliminates the cost of recollection for most parts when regulations change.

- Scrub your parts list by correcting the manufacturing PNs and manufacturer names
- Match against GreenSoft's component database for FMD data

We Collect Conflict Minerals Data

1. GreenSoft will contact your suppliers for a certificate of compliance and ask them to complete an EICC form
2. If suppliers fail to provide any data, GreenSoft will recommend replacement suppliers that will provide a certificate stating compliance with Conflict Minerals regulations or disclosure in EICC form
3. If suppliers use Conflict Minerals from DRC countries, GreenSoft will ask suppliers to disclose smelter/mine information
